### • Administrative Rep Update: Heidi Foley

- Thanks for update on Snow Emergency procedure in Stars Connection.
- Any other New Updates?
  - o January 30<sup>th</sup> no school. Tri Metro Fine Arts Festival: 260 musical/art students here. Concert at 7 pm at night. Arts students just during the day. Select AHA students included in the days.
  - o Long weekend January 26-January 30<sup>th</sup> kids off.
  - o 215 applications for Freshman class. 187 took the test at AHA campus. Class of 2027. 50% ahead in completed applicants. A lot of interest in the school.

#### **Upcoming events:**

#### Angelus coat check (6 parents needed) – Saturday February 4, 2023

- Sign Up genius in Stars Connect this week. Keep in till we get 6-8 volunteers....try to get 8 so if we have fallout, which we typically do, we are covered?
- Discuss feedback and opportunities to encourage students to stay at dances for a longer duration. Thought Starters:

#### 1. In my conversations Music was the #1 issue.

- If music is not good, and there is nothing else to keep students engaged then they get bored and leave.
- Music requested is not always inappropriate but more so, request is for "dance music"
- DJ is not engaged with students or event; often students feel like an annoyance.

## 2. Other opportunities to engage students if they don't want to dance to that particular song.

- Referenced a "Fun" dance previously when there was a photo booth (free) for the kids.
- Change up dances so there all not the same: at Sadie's for ex.: Where they tend to come in costumes/themes: have a contest that drags out a bit throughout the night....start with top 5 and narrow throughout the few hours...winner gets Starbucks gift card?
- Could we have Karaoke intermingled with the dance?
- If doing dances in the gym: is it possible to have "Just Dance" XBOX game on other half of gym (put down divider) to follow along and dance with group.
- Change up the root beer option: can we do an ice cream bar, slushy stand, Maui Wowie stand?
- On the two dances, Sadie's and Angelus dances (the ones that are typical for being asked to) can there be a more slow dances prior to end of dance.

## SENIOR PARTY – Sunday June 4, 2023

- Dine –In/Dine Out: 2nd event January 23<sup>rd</sup>: AT Pizza Luce All Day (Richfield location) 10% of all sales go back to AHA Sr. party. First dine in/out brought in \$424.
- Heidi do we need to send each flier to Mr. Melhorn if using same format? Decision: send to Heidi and AHA will put in Stars Connection and other places.

#### Any direction from administrative committee on below:

- TOPS: Sr. Yard Signs: have agreed to waive design fee; SPPC wanting to sell for \$15.00 and profit goes to sr. party: \$500 fundraiser if we sell 100.
