A supportive teaching culture benefits students and teachers alike

Back to School Night and Parent-Teacher Conferences, which both took place during the first trimester this fall, are annual events where current parents meet their student's teachers, learn what each course offers, and check on student academic progress. These two events offer important outreach from the Academy of Holy Angels faculty to develop and grow trust and partnership between students, parents/guardians, and school staff in order to provide each student with the best possible education.

While the events often receive positive feedback, the last few years have seen a greater amount of accolades. This year, through many emails, phone calls, and conversations, teachers and parents were singing their praises about their individual experiences at AHA. "Receiving this feedback is good, positive affirmation of our school culture," said Principal Heidi Foley. She went on to say, "One parent told me that a new teacher shared how great AHA is after just a few weeks here - that the students are great, the colleagues great, that she can actually teach."

As a Catholic, college-preparatory high school, one of the school's primary focuses, as stated in its mission, is to help each student excel intellectually. For AHA students, learning is an opportunity for challenge, growth, and exploration through a wide variety of classes, including core curriculum, electives, and faith and service. Offering a robust and well-rounded curriculum requires the school to hire teachers who are content experts, and it is something on which the school prides itself.

Teachers receive support through regular class observations, usually performed by Principal Foley or a peer teacher. Jack Dayton, computer science and digital arts teacher, is new to AHA, but not new to teaching. He has taught at three other schools across the country. He shared, "It's so much different here. I've already had three of my classes observed – not from a critical place, but from a curious, supportive role. I've felt such sincere care from Heidi and my colleagues. It makes me feel deeply valued as a teacher." On how this impacts his teaching, Mr. Dayton said, "We are allowed to take our teaching deeper and try new, cutting-edge things. Holy Angels balances its rich, traditional culture with a forward-thinking educational approach, and the students and teachers benefit from that."

The families who make the decision to send their children to Holy Angels also play an important role in its culture. Of that, Malia Lahr, science teacher and department chair, added, "I give credit to our parents who are willing to make a sacrifice to pay tuition. I know that they want their kids to be here because they think education is important, and, in turn, the students also think education is important." Ms. Lahr, who's taught at AHA for 11 years, said the respectful environment allows her to take her lessons further, benefiting the students. "I would look at myself as both a scientist and a teacher, so I'm grateful that I have a job where I can dive deeper into the subject and share my passions with our students."

Math teacher Adam Berkowitz began at Holy Angels in 2018, taught out east for four years, and then moved back to Minnesota this fall. He, too, says that there is something special about AHA which made him eager to return. "A big thing I've noticed that is unique to Holy Angels is that people seem to really enjoy working here. When I talk to my colleagues, we are having friendly chit chat or sharing positive conversation about our jobs. Additionally, the fact that I haven't had to deal with discipline at all is a testament to the culture of the school, the students, and the parents."

Although sometimes more difficult to quantify with grades and test results, there is a strong desire by the school faculty to not only teach students but also develop the whole person. Ms. Lahr said, "We're all trying to teach these students how to be good people. That should be taught right alongside the core curriculum. This school really encourages us to do that. I am thankful that I am free to speak of morality and ethics. It's more important to me that you leave here as a kind person than a straight-A science student."

AHA teachers have an average tenure of 13 years, a testament to the school culture. As a way to measure staff satisfaction, the school provides an annual employee survey. The overwhelmingly positive results have earned AHA the designation of a Star Tribune Top Workplace for seven consecutive years (2017-2023), the only high school in Minnesota to receive that honor.

Holy Angels Receives Highest Advanced Placement Honor


Academy of Holy Angels earned Platinum recognition on the 2023 Advanced Placement School Honor Roll.

Platinum is the highest level recognized (Platinum, Gold, Silver, Bronze) and reflects the strength of AHA's college preparatory curriculum. Of the 15,150 eligible schools in the U.S. and Canada, only 6% of them - or 860 schools - were named Platinum. Principal Heidi Foley said, "In accordance with our strategic plan, AHA's college preparatory curriculum advances partnerships with institutions of higher learning for advance placement and offerings for post-secondary credit. The Platinum recognition affirms our commitment to this goal."

The criteria for the Platinum recognition was:

- Expand your school's college culture by enabling 80% of your Class of 2024 to experience 1 AP course before graduating.
- · Assist with college affordability by enabling 50% of your Class of 2024 to earn college credit by earning an AP Exam score of 3.
- Optimize student's college readiness by creating opportunities for 15% of your Class of 2024 to take a total of 5 APs across their high school years, with at least 1 taken in 9th or 10th grade.

Jake, whose family immigrated to the U.S. from Ecuador, is an accomplished senior who is pursuing a STEM Diploma and is captain of Math STARS. The girls finished the season with a record of 19-2-1. Congratulations, STARS!




AHA Alum Tommy Shelstad '19

Celebrating Legacy! Four Generations of Holy Angels Students

This year, there are two legacy families who've had four generations attend AHA! As the school approaches 100 years in Richfield, it is interesting to consider what has changed and what has stayed the same. Here are some reflections and pictures from these first fourth-generation Holy Angels families.



Mary Ann Scholz Welter '42

From Judy Welter Shea '65:

My grandparents, Peter and Bertha Scholz, were early members of Assumption in Richfield. In 1941, they decided to send their daughter, my mother, Mary Ann Scholz Welter '42, to the new all-girls Catholic high school because it was much closer to their home. Mary Ann and her husband Jim had 11 children of their own and raised their family at 7620 Nicollet. Five of their children attended Holy Angels, including Clare, Paula, Ben, Mike, Ted, and me.

I started in 1961, and I loved everything about Holy Angels. I have many, many fond memories from my years there. It was great that it was all-girls at the time. In my day, most of the teachers were nuns, and they were excellent educators. The lay women teachers we had were also very good. Sr. Irenaeus, who taught English (I fondly recall her teaching us Moby Dick) and directed the theater program, was brilliant. Back then, there weren't any sports offered, so most of us were involved in the theater productions. We did The King and I, Carousel, and Brigadoon.

Five of my children attended Holy Angels: Nat '86, Emily '87, Zak '89, Fran '90, and Andy '92. My daughter Emily '87 married Tom Koenig '87 in the Holy Angels chapel in 1991. Two of their children (Joe '15 and Beatrice '23) have graduated from Holy Angels, and now two of their children currently attend (Francis '25 and Peter '27).

From Emily Shea Koenig '87:

When my mom attended Holy Angels, they had a strict uniform policy. One of the requirements was that socks needed to be pulled up to their knees. My mom, being the rebel that she was and is, would roll her socks down, so

they looked like donuts at her ankles. One day, she was studying in the library and Sr. Avila tapped on her desk with her pencil to get my mom's attention. She explained to my mom that she needed to roll her stockings back up to her knees immediately.

Sr. Avila was still the librarian when I attended Holy Angels. It was a great place to study because she kept the library quiet. Keeping with her effective disciplinary methods, if anyone was talking, she tapped her pencil and the AHA library became silent instantly.

From Frank Koenig '25:

It is very special that I walk the same hallways that my mom, grandma, and even my great-grandma walked. I am grateful to go to AHA knowing that my family has a deep-rooted history here.

From Mary Kelly '68:

My mom, Helen Ryan Hendrickson '36, loved Holy Angels. She was only 12 years old when she joined the class of 1936 as a ninth grader. She chose Holy Angels because it was a new school and her good friends from Holy Name Grade School in South Minneapolis planned to attend.

It was not easy for my mom to get to school. She took the 38th Street streetcar west to Nicollet Avenue, and then she transferred to another streetcar that took her to the end of the line at Nicollet and 58th Street. Holy Angels sent a bus to pick up the Minneapolis girls and take them the rest of the way to 66th Street. She told me that some days the Holy Angels bus didn't start, and they had to walk from the streetcar to school.

It was very important to my parents that my sister, brother and I attend a Catholic high school. Neither my sister, Beth Hendrickson Hawkins '64, nor I really had a choice but to go to Holy Angels. I wanted to go to Richfield High School, but after a while, I grew to love AHA and never regretted my parents' choice. A Catholic education was important enough for my parents that they made sacrifices to make it

possible. That's something I was aware of as a student but understood even better when it was our turn to send our kids to Holy Angels.

Perhaps because I didn't have a choice about where I would attend, it was important to me that my kids had a choice. I'm happy that all five of our children chose Catholic high schools.

I have always considered Holy Angels an extension of our family. I was fortunate that I had cousins who were AHA students and my children (Megan '95, Annie '99 and Mike '01) also had cousins and second cousins who were classmates! Today, my grandchildren have cousins attending at the same time too. This helped with carpools and the general overall feeling of belonging.

The one thing that seems to be the same today as it was in my day is the quality of education and development of the whole student. Also, it's clear to me that teachers and students continue to enjoy one another. When I return to campus, I am able to find some areas that look exactly the same as when I was a student. I enjoy telling my grandchildren there used to be up-only and down-only staircases. They think that's so funny!

From Annie Hawkins LaMere '99:

I feel so fortunate to be able to give the opportunity of a fantastic education from AHA to my children. While many things have changed over the years at the school, some things have stayed the same, including the dedication of the staff and the deep care that they really feel for the students. The commitment of the coaches, parents, and all that support the students has always been a constant at Holy Angels. Our family doesn't take these opportunities for granted. We're thankful every day for the community at AHA.

From Isabella LaMere '24:

I'm grateful that I can go to Holy Angels like many in my family have because I feel more connected with the school. It is fun to talk with my mom about what AHA used to be like. I also enjoy hearing stories about my teachers who also taught her. I am so thankful to have the opportunity to carry on this legacy.

A Promise Kept: A Reunion of Friends

On the first day of homeroom in the fall of 1950, two young women began high school. As custom had it, they were seated in alphabetical order in the two front seats by the holy water font: Madonna Adams, a commuter, and Olga Ana Maria Cristina Andrade Urrejola, a boarder from Guatemala City. Conversation started with irrepressible Olga whispering in Madonna's ear, and with many shared classes, always seated together, they became fast friends. Thus began a high school adventure and a lifelong friendship.

The late 1940's and early 1950's were a relatively stable period in the upper Midwest with a return to peacetime after World War II, and life at AHA reflected this atmosphere.

A bubbly, vivacious, and open young woman with lively, dark eyes and a keen and curious mind, Olga engaged and enlivened everyone around her. Few would forget how she leaped out of her seat in the otherwise calm classroom and rushed to the window exclaiming when she saw her first snowflakes falling. She investigated, analyzed, discovered, and created new life. The Latin Club was but one of her inventions.

Daily exchanges among the commuters and the large number of students from Central and South America introduced the culture of another world before air travel and international study trips took students abroad.

During her sophomore year, Olga's father, Dr. Andrade, died suddenly - a loss that not only changed her family life but undermined her financial situation. Because the program for boarders at Holy Angels was to end in June of 1953, Olga completed her high school requirements early and graduated with the class of 1953, going on to study for a year at The College of St. Catherine.

Before Olga returned to Guatemala in 1954, the two friends met for goodbyes. They planned to write, and, in those days before computers, Olga promised to phone should she ever return to the U.S. "You have to come to Guatemala sometime," she told Madonna, "and when you come, I will take you to Antigua to see the Old City." Such a trip seemed unlikely after Madonna entered the new cloistered Poor Clare Monastery in Bloomington, MN that fall.

Olga's parting words sounded one, ominous note: "Don't write anything about politics, or I could get in trouble."

On a bus tour in Zurich, Switzerland, Olga met her future husband Maurice Weigel, and they had two daughters, Marie Cecile and Jeanne Eleonore. Skilled in languages, Olga worked at the Swiss Embassy, where on one occasion, as Madonna would later learn, she was taken hostage there with other employees. A timely intervention from abroad saw all released, but at the time, they did fear for their lives.

Then, it happened. In winter of 1968, a call came to the Monastery in Bloomington. Olga was in the U.S. for a weekend with her husband. Her name was well-known to the sisters, who sadly told her that Madonna (Sister Clare) was not there. She had been asked to travel to the monastery in New Orleans to help with music for a solemn profession. "That is where I am!" exclaimed Olga. When the phone rang in New Orleans, Madonna heard the voice of her old friend saying she was in town. She met Olga and Maurice in pouring rain outside the gate of the Poor Clare Monastery near Audubon Park in old New Orleans. They had supper together, talking without pause until the restaurant closed.


After many years, the correspondence suddenly ended, and Madonna wondered whether Olga had died or had moved to Germany where her daughter worked. She contacted the Swiss and American embassies to no avail. Madonna's nephew, Paul Dosh '93, traveling in Central America visited Olga's address, but she was unknown there. This was all the more painful for Madonna, since

times had changed, and she would have been able to visit Olga.

In the spring of 2014, Madonna's sister Millie '57 recalled that Olga had worked at the Swiss Embassy in Guatemala City. She decided to find out if the Embassy had a website. They did! Millie wrote to them, giving a detailed background. She received a reply the next day from a woman who now held the position that Olga had held. She said that Olga had been at the Embassy just a few weeks before, and that she was not in good health.

Madonna was stunned by the news and decided to visit Olga. She quickly planned a trip with the help of Olga's daughter, Eleonore, to see her old friend. In June of 2014, Madonna went to Guatemala and spent a week talking with Olga and catching up on the intervening years. Although Olga was crippled with rheumatoid arthritis, her voice faint from a small stroke, the two friends were reunited at last. Olga had been receiving the Communiqué and was full of questions about her classmates and friends.



Eleonore took Madonna on a tour of Antigua, the old city, with people dressed in the brilliant colors of the traditional garb and the beauty of churches that had escaped the earthquakes were filled with prayer. They also visited the former Poor Clare Monastery, now a museum, so familiar in its layout to Madonna.

Olga had kept her promises.

When Madonna returned home to the U.S., Olga's regular letters and cards resumed. However, when correspondence faded, Madonna called Olga's daughter to inquire. She learned that Olga had celebrated her 80th birthday in March 2017 with her family, but died of pneumonia on December 16, 2017.

Olga's daughter Eleonore remains in contact with Madonna as good friends. The friendship, begun 70 years ago between two young girls, continues today – a lovely gift of Gods Providence.



The Summer of 2023

In the summer of 2023, Olga's daughter, Eleonore, traveled from Guatemala to the United States to visit Madonna. On June 7, they visited Academy of Holy Angels and had a full and very fun tour of the school filled with memories and laughter. Months later, Madonna established the Adams-Andrade Catholic Friendship Scholarship Fund which will be awarded annually to a Catholic female student with a significant preference for a Latina student.



After three years of limited reunions, it was fun to see so many alums return to campus to reunite with classmates. Four pre-co-ed reunions took place at Holy Angels this fall while three co-ed reunions took place at Rock the Lawn last summer. From the President

Dear AHA Community,

Included in this fall Communiqué is our 2022-23 Annual Report, highlighting the achievements and financial progress of our school. The Annual Report reaffirms AHA's commitment to high standards of academic excellence and Catholic values, preparing our students for leadership and service as people of faith.

The progress we have made, and continue to make, is what will be shared with you in the pages ahead. Your gifts to Holy Angels for scholarship, academic programming, and other initiatives have impacted our exceptional students and teachers. I am pleased and humbled to share with you this report and to highlight a portion of the AHA success story for 2022-23:

- The school completed a \$500,000 renovation of the "vintage" M building only relying on operational funding;
- Advancement efforts saw unprecedented success in the school's Annual Fund by raising over \$2 million in support;
- 100% of our 2023 graduates received diplomas, and 97% are enrolled in college;
- The class of 2023 received \$16.3 million in college scholarship offerings and accepted \$4.5 million;
- AHA awarded \$2.5 million in financial aid and merit-based scholarship assistance to 475 students;
- AHA continued its quest to show decline in long-term debt service and positioned itself to retire the debt in 2024;
- 17 AP classes were offered in 2022-23 to 282 students who completed 570 Advanced Placement examinations;
- Five 2023 graduates received National Merit Scholarship recognition last academic year;
- Racial diversity in 2022-23 grew to nearly 30%, reflecting AHA's efforts of fostering inclusivity in all grades;
- The composite ACT test score for the class of 2023 was 25.2, considerably higher than both state and national averages.

The 2022-23 audited financial results once again reflect the story of a fiscally sound institution. For the twelfth straight year, Academy of Holy Angels has presented



a balanced budget, which through strong stewardship, has manifested itself to show an excess at year end. The Finance Department, Finance Committee of the Board, and the Administration have been diligent in their oversight of the expenses for program services which includes our instructional, StarDome, and transportation offerings. Expense levels have been maintained and have exhibited minor increases that are relevant in relation to our total support revenues in each area. Once again, the school utilized the audit services of Boyum & Barenscheer who, in November, released a material error-free audit for 2022-23.

As always, I cannot express enough gratitude to our friends who continue to amaze me by your support of Academy of Holy Angels. Keeping class sizes educationally-advantaged, tuition affordable, programming visionary, and faculty enhanced have always been at the heart of our Catholic school. Our community continues to embrace these tenets of our mission. Holy Angels continues to stand strong in the values of our founders, the Sisters of St. Joseph of Carondelet and our Catholic heritage.

Thank you to every contributor to Academy of Holy Angels for your unwavering support of our great school. Together, we have impacted the lives of students today and for decades to come.




